## EXECUTIVE SESSION TO BE HELD ON Tuesday, January 12 at 4:00pm

The Executive Session is held pursuant to I.C. § 5-14-1.5-6.1(b): (check all that apply)

(1) Where authorized by federal or state statute.
(2) For discussion of strategy with respect to any of the following: A. Collective bargaining xxB. Initiation of litigation or litigation that is either pending or has been specifically threatened in writing C. The implementation of security systems C. The purchase or lease of real property by the governing body up to the time of contract or option to purchase or lease is executed by the parties. E. School consolidation
(3) For discussion of the assessment, design, and implementation of school safety measures, plans, and systems.
(5) To receive information about and interview prospective employees.
<ul> <li>(6) With respect to any individual over whom the governing body has jurisdiction:</li> <li>(A) to receive information concerning the individual's alleged misconduct; and</li> <li>(B) to discuss, before a determination, the individual's status as an employee, a student, or an independent contractor who is a (i) physician; or (ii) a school bus driver.</li> </ul>
(7) For discussion of records classified as confidential by state or federal statute.
(8) To discuss before a placement decision an individual student's abilities, past performance, behavior, and needs.
(9) To discuss a job performance evaluation of individual employees. This subdivision does not apply to a discussion of the salary, compensation, or benefits of employees during a budget process.
(10) When considering the appointment of a public official, to do the following:  (A) Develop a list of prospective appointees.  (B) Consider applications.  (C) Make one (1) initial exclusion of prospective appointees from further consideration.
(11) To train school board members with an outside consultant about the performance of the role of the members as public officials.
(12) To prepare or score examinations used in issuing licenses, certificates, permits, or registrations under IC 25.
(13) To discuss information and intelligence intended to prevent, mitigate, or respond to the threat of terrorism.
